MUMBAI MetLife India Insurance reported a net profit of ₹35.35 crore for the financial year ended March 31, 2011, against a loss of 7274.82 crore reported in 2009-10, mainly due to improved operational efficiency and planned sales. Operating expenses have declined 17.32% to ₹563.84 crore compared with 7681.99 crore for the year ended March 31, 2010. The insurer registered a total revenue at ₹2,615.13 crore for the year ended March 31, 2011, against ₹2,627.63 crore in the previous fiscal. Renewal income witnessed a 22% jump and grew to ₹1,801.95 crore from ₹1,474.16 crore in the same period last year.
